









NOTICE OF RACE Open Dutch Championship

Efsix, Spanker & Sailhorse class

organised by WV Braassemermeer

under the auspices of the RNWA from 17 september to 19 september (inclusive) 2021 (Sailhorse 18 & 19 september) location: Roelofarendsveen

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS*). The Prescriptions of the RNWA can be found at http://www.sailing.org/documents/racingrules/national_prescriptions.php.
- 1.2 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing, Windsurfing and Kiteboarding' (available at <u>reglement-voor-kampioenschappen-20191101-v5-docx.pdf (watersportverbond.nl)</u> will apply.
- 1.3 The Sailing Instructions may change some RRS-rules. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may change other rules as well
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.5 Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after September 1st on the website of the Class Organization www.spanker.nl, www.spanker.nl, www.sailhorse.nl and WV Braassemermeer https://www.braassemermeer.nl

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the regatta office.
- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Spanker, Efsix and Sailhorse classes.
- 4.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online before september 15th, 2021 at www.spanker.nl, www.efsix.nl, www.spanker.nl, www.efsix.nl, www.spanker.nl, www.spanker.nl.
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4 Late entries will not be accepted.

5 FEES

5.1 Entry fees are as follows:

9 SCHEDULE

- 9.1 Registration shall take place on Friday September 17th 2021 from 09:00 hrs to 11:00 hrs fort he Spanker and Efsix class
- 9.2 Registration shall take place on Friday September 17th 2021 from 20:00 hrs to 21:00 hrs, and on 18th september from 08:00 hrs to 09:00hrs for the Sailhorse class.
- 9.3 Each boat shall confirm its entry for the regatta at the regatta office before the start of the first race.

10 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 10.1 Each boat shall produce or verify a valid measurement certificate.
- 10.2 Boats may be inspected at any time.

13 COURSES

13.1 The courses to be sailed will be a Inner/Outerloop and will be further specified in the Sailing Instructions.

14 SPARE

15 SCORING

- 15.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 15.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 15.3 RRS 90.3(e) applies.

18 [DP] BERTHING

18.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park (Spanker) or Harbour (Efsix & Sailhorse)

19 [DP] HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

19.1 Efsix and Sailhorse boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

20 [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

20.1 For the Efsix and Sailhorse class, underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.

21 DATA PROTECTION

21.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

22 RISK STATEMENT

- 22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 22.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

23 INSURANCE

23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

24 PRIZES

24.1 The RNWA supplies for the winning boat or team a blue pennant and a medal for every member of the crew of the first three boats or crews (there will be no extra medals available for changes in the crew during the event).

Other prizes will be given as follows:

Spanker: the first five boats.

Efsix: Floating Trophy and a consolation price. Sailhorse: Floating Trophy and the first five boats.
